POLICIES & INFORMATION

- **Conclave Roster Form** is attached with this e-mail. Please fill in the roster document and e-mail to **BOTH** faithh@cho-yeh.org & mmarcotte@pbyofnewcovenant.org by the two-week out date listed on your confirmation.
- **Assumption of Risk Form/Health Statement - attached on next 2 pages.** Please make copies and have each participant fill one out (they can be front & back copies). These forms must be turned in upon your arrival at Cho-Yeh.
- **Meals** are served at 8:00am, 12:00pm, and 5:30pm. Please be on time to meals.
- **First Aid and Emergency Care** are the responsibility of the group.
 - Cho-Yeh advises that the group bring someone with a nationally recognized certification in CPR & First Aid.
 - Transportation for emergencies is the responsibility of the group.
 - First Aid supplies and equipment are the responsibility of the group.
 - Cho-Yeh advises that the group gain contact information, medical history and permission to treat for all participants.
- **Children** should always be accompanied by an adult when traveling about the grounds. For safety reasons and legal obligations, adult leadership must supervise ALL activities and stay in cabins with youth under the age of 18.
- **Camp Fires** are permitted with approval and supervision of the Cho-Yeh staff. The fire should be built in the fire circle area only. Always extinguish your fire before leaving the area.
- **Alcohol** is NOT permitted on the camp side of our facility at any time.
- **Tobacco/Illegal Drugs** are not permitted on Cho-Yeh property.
- **Food and Drink** should not be taken inside the cabins or hotel rooms.
- **Vehicles** should be parked in paved, designated areas and stay parked during your stay unless cleared by a camp staff member.
- **Speed Limit** signs are posted in camp. The speed limit in camp is 15 mph. Always be mindful of pedestrians on the camp grounds.
- **Camp Grounds** are consistently maintained to keep Cho-Yeh clean and natural. Trees, shrubbery and flowers are not to be cut, carved, broken, or plucked.
- **Trash Cans** are located throughout the Cho-Yeh grounds. Please help keep camp clean by placing all trash in the trash cans.
- **Restricted Areas** are designated for your protection. No one is allowed in these areas without being accompanied by a Cho-Yeh Staff member.
- **Weapons** are NOT permitted on Cho-Yeh property. The use of Cho-Yeh equipment such as a rifle or bow & arrow are limited to activities where trained Cho-Yeh personnel are instructing a class.
- **Energy Conservation** is appreciated. Please turn off the lights when you are not in your cabin.
- **Pets** should be left at home.
- **Departure** should consist of making sure no belongings are left behind in the cabins or meeting space, trash

pick-up around your facility, and a check to make sure no misuse or damage to the facility has occurred.

- No dinner will be served on Friday night.
- Registration for Conclaves begins at 6:30 PM on Friday night with the program starting at 8:00 PM.
- Conclaves will end at 12 Noon on Sunday. No lunch will be served on Sunday.

- Comfortable, Sturdy Clothing
- Walking shoes, Socks & Shower Shoes
- **Water bottle**
- Money for canteen & Trading Post purchases

DIRECTIONS TO CHO-YEH (in Livingston, TX)

- Cho-Yeh is located: 55 miles north of Humble, TX & 90 miles north of downtown Houston on HWY 59. Cho-Yeh is approximately 50 miles south of Lufkin, TX on HWY 59. Cho-Yeh is approximately 180 miles south of Dallas and 360 miles northeast of San Antonio.

From Houston, Heading North on Highway 59

- (You will pass through Cleveland, Shepherd, and Goodrich. Livingston is approximately 8 miles north of Goodrich.) As you come into Livingston you will pass *The Lake Livingston Inn* and a large Ford dealership on your right. Approximately one mile from these landmarks the highway will form a 3rd lane on your right. Get in the right lane and make an actual right turn off the Highway (TURN BEFORE THE EXIT). (A green highway sign stating "CAMP CHO-YEH" is located immediately before the turn, and the East Texas Realty building is on your right when you turn onto the feeder road.) Follow the feeder road to the first street and turn right. Cho-Yeh is approximately one mile up the road. (If you come to the HWY 190 exit while on HWY 59 you have gone too far.)

From Lufkin (& the Hwy 190/Hwy 59 Intersection), Heading South on Highway 59 –

As you travel south on HWY 59 through Livingston, you will pass the intersection of HWY 59 and HWY 190. Approximately 1-1.5 miles past this intersection you will go under an overpass (only overpass you will see). About half a mile past the overpass get into the left-hand turn lane. (This is the first crossover you will come to after the overpass!) Turn left at this turn lane and cross the oncoming lanes of traffic onto the feeder road (you will be heading north on the feeder road). Follow the feeder road to the first street and take a right. Camp Cho-Yeh is approximately one mile up the road.
